Our governing Board of Directors and staff represent several different denominations. We have no intention of replacing the church structure, but work alongside our volunteers to connect students and their families with partner churches.

We Equip Volunteers

Volunteers from local churches are an integral part of effective programs. Our staff's primary role is to: create and develop programs that effectively carry out the mission, recruit, train and empower volunteers from the church to minister to the youth, reach out to students, obtain necessary authorizations, and transportation, provide facilities that are safe, and administer effective development programs. We equip called volunteers to serve hundreds of students who attend program at Freedom locations across lowa each week.

Support Sources

We are funded primarily through donations from individual believers and church mission budgets, and a small percentage comes through foundations and corporations. The ministry receives NO government funding.



Expectations
